ZJU-UCLA Summer Research Program

Established in March 2005, the Zhejiang University-UCLA Summer Research Program (ZJU-UCLA SRP), an intensive summer research training experience designed for junior/senior undergraduate students who are preparing for careers in medical research or engineering.



ZJU-UCLA Summer Research Program

Mission : to expand international scientific collaboration and to promote career development of future medical researchers and engineers.



The Crimson Summer Exchange (CSE)

A cross-cultural elite education program that serves as a cultural bridge for outstanding western universities students and Chinese youth in a creative learning environment intended to inspire students' passion and potential.



The Crimson Summer Exchange (CSE)

The two week CSE program is led by outstanding students (Fellow) from Harvard, Yale, Cambridge, Oxford and students (Co-fellow) from Zhejiang University.

It provides CSE students (Junior-fellow) with comprehensive training under the theme of "Inspiring the Next Generation".



CSE Program Highlights:

1. Crimson Icebreakers 特色破冰

Each group cooperates with teammates to complete 8 to 10 game tasks and successful completion of tasks leads to the final boss game at the terminal.

2. Enrichment Courses 创新课程

Students rotate through the schedule, gaining the opportunity to work with a variety of ideas, student groups, teaching styles and fellows over the course of the program.



3.Model United Nations 模拟联合国

The MUN is designed for students to become knowledgeable in the operations of the United Nations. Students will be given a single topic to research and will ensure the debate is covered in depth and maximize the pedagogical value of the entire exercise.

4. Outdoor Development 户外拓展训练

Outdoor Development stems from nautical training and aims at fostering the personal growth and social skills of participants by carrying out challenging tasks in the outdoors and the ability to survive harsh conditions by teaching confidence and tenacity.



5. Community Services 社区服务

Students conduct research on the needs of local community, and then devise an innovative plan on how they may help to solve problems facing the community around them.

6. Drama 戏剧表演

Intended to showcase teamwork, spoken English and the range of students' expression expanded during CSE, drama performance culminates in a 10 to 20 minute film.



7. Beyond the Limit 超越极限

The objective of Beyond the Limit is to accumulate all the students' experience and what they have learned throughout the entire duration of the program to contact a company and conduct research and present their findings in public.

8. Life at University 大学生活探讨

This module introduces and highlights the similarities and differences in university life between China and the West and second, through and honest sharing exercise, bond the fellows closer to their students and vice versa.

- (1) Appreciate different cultures, backgrounds and knowledge
- (2) Inspire innate potential; promote self-confidence
- (3) Nurture a positive attitude to life and a self-motivated passion for learning
- (4) Encourage creative thinking; address problems from multiple perspectives
- (5) Polish English communication skills
- (6) Enhance social, teamwork and leadership potential
- (7) Foster responsibility of a global citizen
- (8) Develop life-long friendship and partnerships
