- 2005 Celebrated its Centennial on May 5, 2005



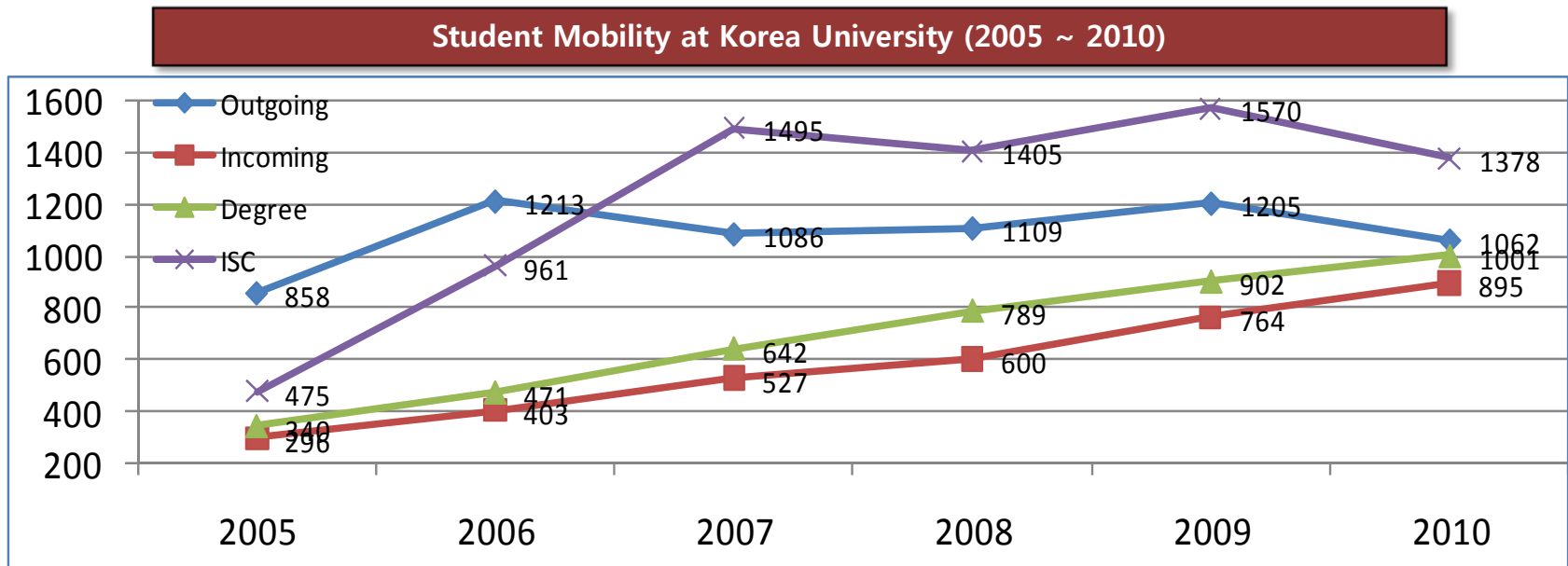

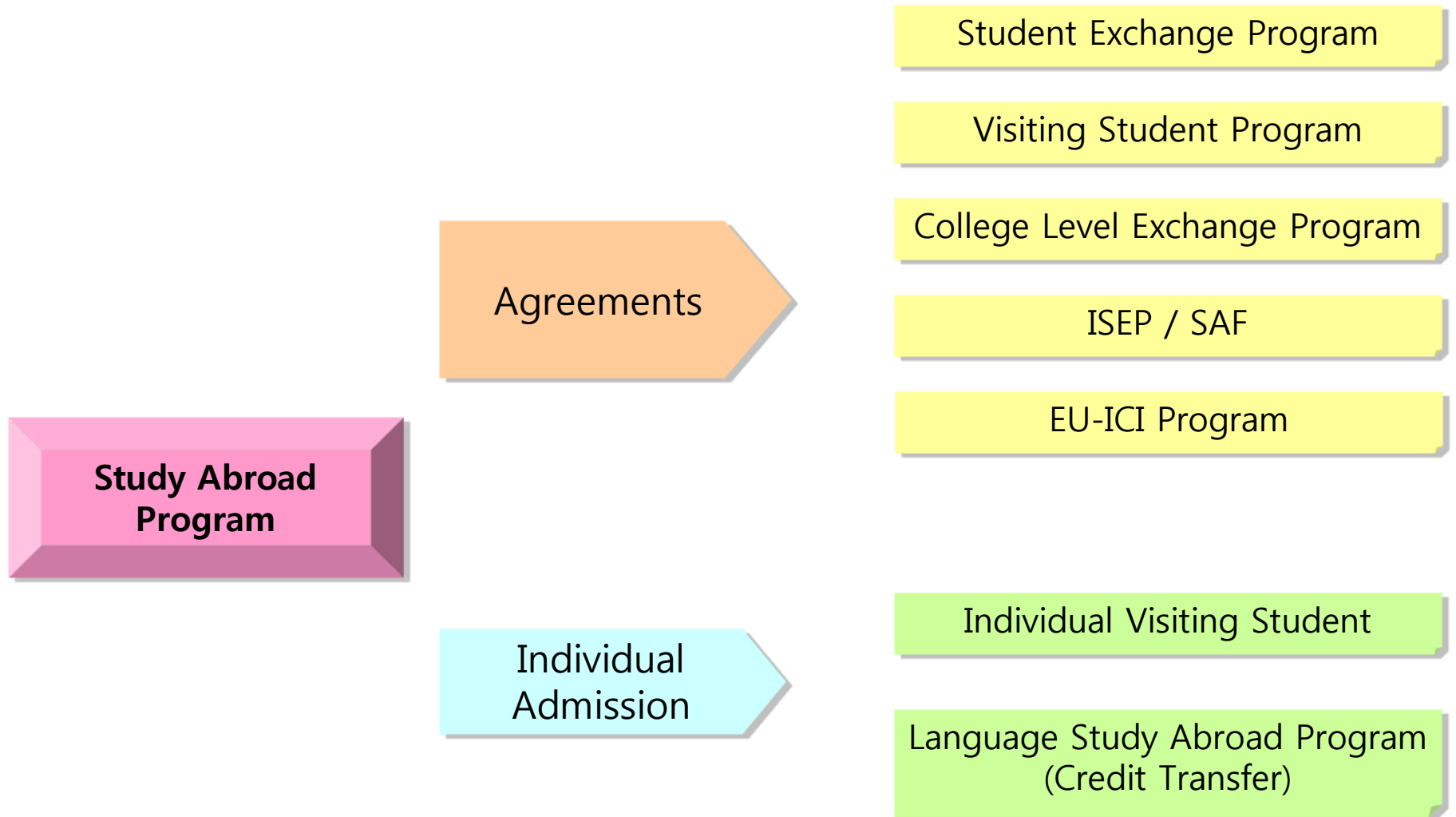

 - √ Join in semester events and activities

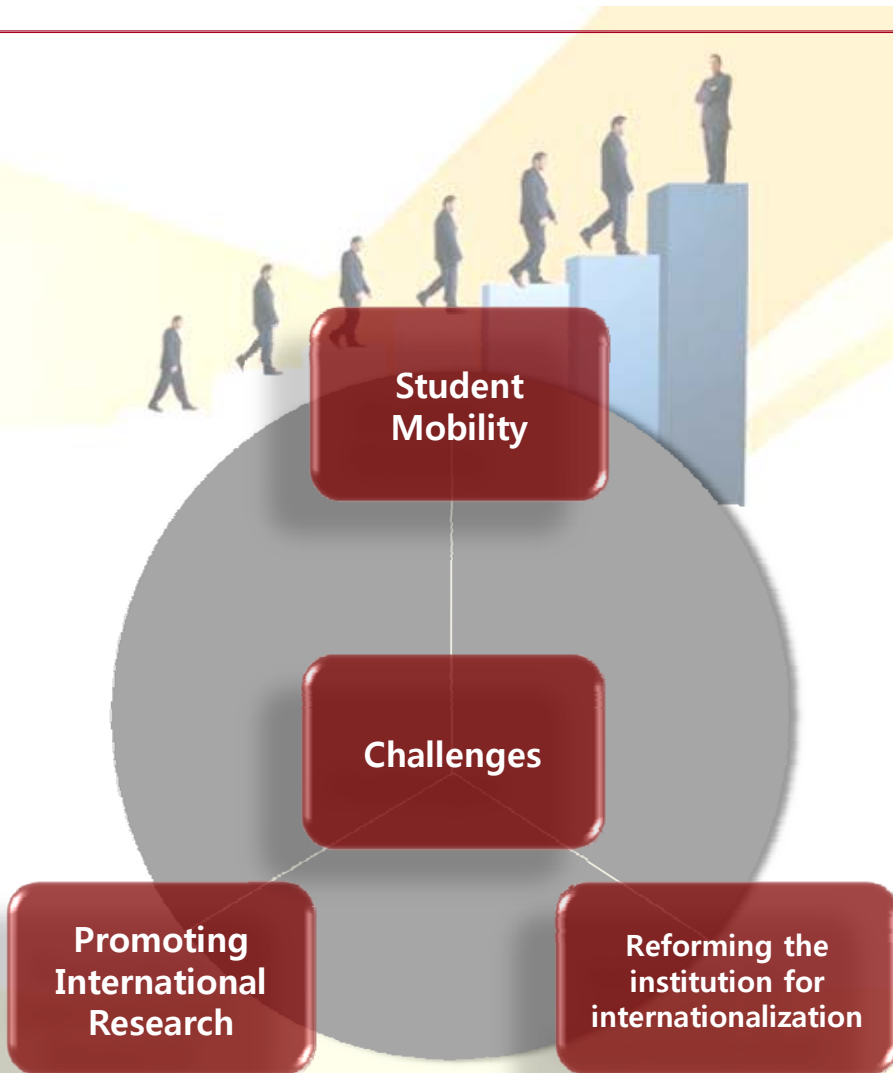
The Office of International Affairs produces and distributes the KUBA DVD at the end of the semester. The DVD contains video clips and pictures of every events occurred during the semester >
