






Diversity of Host Universities for Outgoing 2010

New system of "Self-sent" for Fudan undergraduates



- Aim: Provide more overseas study opportunities for Fudan students
- Non-degree program (1semester or 1year)
- Choose165 universities (The name list is a bit different from the exchange partners.)
- Credit conversion

Advantages & Disadvantages



Advantages:

- -Have more choices and chances, especially to the B-level students.
- -Be able to graduate in 4 years with 1 semester or 1 year overseas study experience.

Disadvantages:

- -Pay tuition to both home institution and host institution.
- -Economic burden

Financial Support for Overseas Study



- From home institutions (Fudan and colleges)
 - Scholarships
- From host institutions
 - Scholarships
 - Tuition waived or reduced
- From international, national, municipal foundations for overseas study
- Fund raising
 - Alumni
 - Entrepreneurs
