A Brief History




- In 1911, Tsing Hua Academy was instituted at Tsing Hua Garden in Beijing
- In 1928, the name was changed to Tsing Hua University after Undergraduate Program was established In 1929, Graduate Program was started
- University Motto
 - To Oneself Be True; Give Nature Its Due 厚德載物,自強不息







- In 1956, the University was re-installed in Hsinchu, and the first college was the College of Nuclear Science.
- Since 1984, the University established the Colleges of Humanities and Social Sciences, Life Science, Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, and Technology Management, making Tsing Hua a more comprehensive research university












Orientation

Daily exhibition of cuisines and specials from different countries (India, Malaysia, Korea, Vietnam and Honduras...)








Foreign Student Association (FSA)

Library: Access to the comprehensive and extensive collection of 3.05 million titles (printed and digital books, journals, microfilms, audio-visual and multimedia resource)














- One fourth of world's population speaks mandarin. Learning mandarin will facilitate one's quest for knowledge in Taiwan.







Vision and Strategies
