

- The UI campus is set in over 312 hectares of lush, tropical greenery. Space is allocated as follows:
 - Physical buildings and green landscape buffer zones (170 ha):
 - Water ecosystems including six lakes which function as water absorption zones (30 ha)
 - City forest area (100 ha)
 - Supporting facilities and infrastructure, including an environment buffer (12 ha)
- The University established its Green Metric World University ranking system in April 2010 to promote campus sustainability. Over 100 universities are currently participating.






UI's plans for the future
