Abstract

Internationalized Domestic Students: Lesson Learned from Kasetsart University By Poonpipope Kasemsap, Ph.D.¹

Internationalization in one dimension refers to a process of a university for successful participation and exists in an increasing interdependent world through a process of integration various international factors into the teaching, training, and researching aiming to produce graduates to become global citizens. As Kasetsart University is a public university in Thailand where most of courses are conducted in Thai (our national language), to internationalize domestic students seems to be a challenge under different infusions. Internationalization of domestic students needs to be organized and directive, and also proactive, not reactive. Success in internationalization of our domestic students is the result of the following factors: 1) Student Mobility, 2) Academic Cooperation with Internationalization, and 6) the University Investment.

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
