International Student Mobility: Recent initiatives and future approaches 6th University Administrator's Workshop Kyoto University, 22-23 February 2011

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Abstract

The presentation deals with issues that have a bearing on international student mobility at Universitas Indonesia. In the introduction, the university's vision and mission statement and a brief history of the university are given.

In the first part of the presentation, the focus is on the present condition at the university. There is an overview of the faculties and programs at all levels including professional, specialist and international classes. A picture is also given of facilities, including IT-based facilities and laboratories. The education system is described along with student admission routes and statistics on a number of student related aspects. In addition, the various aspects of international engagement and knowledge transfer and international learning and teaching are also covered.

In the second part of the presentation, a description is given of how the university is developing strategically towards the future. The university has plans to enlist the help of more adjunct professors and foreign guest lecturers. The number of international classes, and joint and double degree programs will also be increased. In addition, UI is working to set up an ASEAN-wide credit transfer system that will also make it easier for students from all countries in the region to study abroad.
