Seminar on Japan-ASEAN Co-learning Future Vision on Collaboration between Public Sector and Private Sector in Civil Engineering Practices

In recent years, public-private partnerships have become more active in the development of infrastructure for electricity, transportation and water resources management etc. in ASEAN countries as well as in Japan. In the current situation, however, there is no common understanding regarding the desirable form of public-private collaboration. As both Japan and ASEAN face a growing shortage of human resources due to the declining birthrate and aging population, public-private partnerships in the development of public infrastructure will become increasingly important in the future.
