

Erasmus+ Scholarships for Staff Mobility for Teaching or Training at Technical University of Munich (Erasmus+ International Dimension)

The Technical University of Munich invites staff members for teaching or training purposes to apply for grants made available by the European Union under the international dimension of the Erasmus+ program.

Background and goals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Fostering institutional engagement with TUM, through exchange of best practice and development of new formats of cooperation ■ Enhancing existing student mobility, especially to increase incoming mobility to TUM ■ To deepen existing ties with the two institutions, in particular through exchange of academic staff on departmental and central level
Funding possibilities and fundable duration of stay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Staff Mobility for Training (STT): at least 5 days (not including travel days!)* ■ Staff Mobility for Teaching (STA): at least 5 days (not including travel days!)* (At least eight hours of lectures must be held at TUM per week or part of a week.) ■ Please note that <u>research activities cannot be funded!</u> However a teaching stay (STA) can be combined with a research stay. <p>Stay at TUM until June 2021</p>
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Administrative and scientific staff members who are in a position of getting an official authorization of business travel
Support	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ 160 € per day (from the 15th day 112 € per day) ■ 1500 € travel expenses ■ Please be aware that the Erasmus+ Program provides no insurance. It is the staff member's responsibility to insure herself/himself for the whole duration of the stay (medical, accident and liability insurance).
Application and selection process	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Applications must be submitted to heidelberg@oc.kyoto-u.ac.jp (Erasmus+ coordinator at our European Centre in Heidelberg, Germany). No direct applications to TUM will be accepted! ■ The application should include following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ - copy of ID/Passport ■ - CV ■ - application form including project description and time schedule ■ - a letter of invitation from a TUM staff member ■ - a proof of employment at the home university

* The budget available does not allow to fund longer stays than 1, max. 2 weeks, depending on number of applications.
