Description of Research Interests:

Jonathan Beaverstock is the International Director for the Faculty of Social Sciences and Law, and Professor of International Management. He joined the University of Bristol in January 2014. Previously, he held the Chair of Economic Geography and Directorship of the 'Integrating Global Society' Research & Knowledge Transfer Priority Group at the University of Nottingham, UK (2007-2013). From 1991-2007, Jonathan held several positions at Loughborough University, UK, including Professor and Head of the School of Geography (2003-2007).

Jonathan has held Honorary and Guest Visiting Professorships at the National University of Singapore, the University of Ghent and the University of Western Sydney, and in 2006 was appointed the Ron Lister Visiting Fellow at the University of Otago, New Zealand. In 2012, Jonathan was conferred a Fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences. Jonathan is a graduate of the University of Wales, Lampeter (BA Geography, 1986) and the University of Bristol (PhD, Economic Geography, 1990).

As an interdisciplinary social scientist, Jonathan's research spans international business management, economic-urban geography and migration studies, chiefly investigating the internationalization of knowledge-intensive professionals and globalizing professional service firms in global financial centres.
