Dr. Ito was born in 1951 in Saitama Prefecture. He obtained his Ph.D. from the Graduate School of Letters, Kyoto University. After receiving a scholarship from the Italian government and studying at the Faculty of Political Science, University of Milan, he was appointed Associate Professor at the Kobe City University of Foreign Studies, and later appointed Associate Professor and, subsequently, Professor at the Faculty of Human Sciences, Osaka University. In 2005, he took up his present position at the Graduate School of Letters, Kyoto University. He specializes in culture sociology, political sociology, and gender studies. His former and current roles include President of the Japanese Sports Sociology Society, President of the Japan Gender Studies Society (since 2007), member of the Gender Equality Professional Examination Board of the Cabinet Office, United Nations Population Fund Tokyo Office Advisor Board member, and council member of the Science Council of Japan. He is a co-author of *Mirror of Modernity: Invented Tradition of Modern Japan* (University of California Press, 1998), *Gender, Transgender and Sexualities in Japan* (Routledge, 2007), *Transforming Japan: New Feminism and Diversity are Making a Difference* (The Feminist Press at the City University of New York, 2011), and *Gender and Welfare States in Eastern Asia: Confucianism or Gender Equality?* (Macmillan, 2014) and a co-editor of *International Encyclopedia of Men & Masculinities* (Routledge, 2007).
