Symposium summary	<p>The symposium was held on December 11 at Hue University of Agriculture and Forestry (in a hybrid format, including online participation via Zoom). The main objectives of the symposium was to discuss future academic developments based on the outcomes to date of international joint education and research conducted with overseas partner universities, and to provide early career researchers in a wide range of fields with opportunities to present their research results and share and discuss information. The symposium included keynote speeches, poster sessions, and oral presentation sessions. The total number of participants was 301, including researchers, students, and private company members from 52 institutions/organizations in 13 countries (mainly in Asia).</p> <p>The symposium began with opening remarks by President Nagahiro Minato of Kyoto University, Dean Takeshi Katsumi of Kyoto University's Graduate School of Global Environmental Studies, Vice-President Do Thi Xuan Dung of Hue University, and Rector Tran Thanh Duc of Hue University of Agriculture and Forestry (some of the remarks were delivered online), followed by a keynote speech by former Rector Le Van An of Hue University of Agriculture and Forestry. After the keynote speech, Prof. Emeritus Shigeo Fujii of Kyoto University was awarded the title of honorary professor by Hue University, and gave a commemorative speech.</p> <p>In the afternoon, there were five parallel poster presentation sessions of (a total of 114 presentations) and three oral presentation sessions (a total of 13 presentations in the fields of environmental technology, natural resources, and global ecology).</p>
