On December 3, the Kyoto University International Symposium 2024 on Education and Research in Global Environmental Studies in Asia, themed "Measures and Perspectives of Human Resource" Development through International Environmental Cooperation," was held at the Royal University of Agriculture in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, with a hybrid format including Zoom participation. The primary objective was to discuss methodologies and perspectives development through human resource international environmental cooperation, focusing on the Asian region, and to promote the international development of education and research between Kyoto University and its partner universities. The symposium featured keynote speeches, poster sessions (including oral presentations), panel discussions, and collaborative sessions. 360 participants, including researchers, students, and private sector representatives, attended from 48 organizations across 22 countries in Asia, Europe, and the United States.

Symposium summary

The symposium commenced with opening remarks delivered by Nagahiro Minato, President of Kyoto University (via recorded video); Chihiro Tanaka, Dean of the Graduate School of Global Environmental Studies (GSGES); Hirohide Kobayashi, Professor at GSGES; and Ngo Bunthan, President of the Royal University of Agriculture. Keynote speeches followed, featuring Izuru Saizen, Vice Dean of GSGES, and Huon Thavrak, Vice Rector of the Royal University of Agriculture. These were followed by a poster session showcasing 72 research presentations.

The afternoon began with a panel discussion featuring representatives from Kyoto University, the Royal University of Agriculture, Hue University of Agriculture and Forestry, IPB University, ITB, and HUST. A collaborative research proposal session, with seven presentations, was conducted.
