Symposium summary	More than 220 researchers, activists, and graduate students from Japan and abroad participated in the conference. As the fourth edition, this was the first time the conference was held in Asia (the first took place in Spain, the second in Brazil, and the third in Spain and France). True to its international nature, over 60% of the participants came from outside Japan. Due to the distinctive policy of not restricting the languages used, the venue became a genuinely multilingual space throughout the three-day event. In total, the conference featured seven keynote lectures, seventy-two individual presentations, eleven panel discussions, two roundtables, five workshops, and two plenary sessions.
